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INTRODUCTION

The Directorate of Admission, Evaluation and Authentication in the Ministry of Higher Education, Science & Technology congratulates the successful students who passed South Sudan Certificate of Secondary Education in 2023 and invites them to Public and Private Universities of the Republic of South Sudan. The successful applicants who will be nominated and admitted to our National Universities will be the ninth batch since independence. The Directorate is presenting this revised edition of Admission Guidebook to the applicants to assist and guide them in filling their application forms correctly.

Admission process consists of two primary tools: The Admission Form and Admission Guide. The Admission Guidebook is the most important tool that guides the applicant while filling the admission form. Hence, each applicant must read the Admission Guidebook thoroughly before filling the Admission Form. Failure to do so will have implications on the choices that the applicant shall make. Therefore, reading and understanding instructions in the Guidebook is the first step to secure admission.

This tenth edition of Admission Guidebook consists of four sections. Each section contains useful information for admission process. Section One contains the basis and regulations for admission. It comprises of four chapters. Each chapter spells out the requirements for admission. Section Two contains information on public and private institutions of higher education; Section Three elaborates the process of application to universities and concentrates on the qualifying subjects; Section Four provides the names and codes of colleges for bachelor and diploma programs.

Applicants should read and understand the Admission Guidebook thoroughly before filling out the Admission Form carefully. Instructions on how to fill the admission form are illustrated in section three. Filling the form correctly is a key to secure Admission.

It is our solemn hope that this ninth edition of Admission Guide will assist applicants in applying to universities correctly and successfully.

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CHAPTER ONE

Bases and Regulations of Nomination for Admission

1. Nomination and admission are carried out according to the following procedures:

- 1.1 An applicant is nominated for admission in accordance to the arrangement of his/her choices in the application form;
- 1.2 The result of admission is announced by publishing the percentage of admission in all institutions of higher education through the official media. Nominated applicants' names for admission are also announced;
- 1.3 The Directorate of Admission corrects any mistakes in the nomination for admission within the duration specified by the admission committee;

2. General Conditions for Admission to the University.

Conditions for admission are as follows:

- 2.1 Pass in South Sudan Certificate of Secondary Education of year 2023 or its equivalent; with minimum percentage;
- 2.2 Admission processes begin within 30 days of the announcement of South Sudan Certificate of Secondary Education;
- 2.3 Second admission should take place within two weeks after the announcement of the first admission results;
- 2.4 Applications are allowed only to the holders of the current certificate;
- 2.5 Holders of old certificates shall apply directly to the Universities;

2.6 Students who have South Sudan Certificate of Secondary Education from Arts section and also who obtained certificate of higher nursing shall be allowed to apply for Diploma in Nursing, but shall undergo bridging courses in Chemistry, Biology, Physics and Mathematics before Registration;

3 Conditions for admission to Bachelor Degree:

3.1 Admission to Bachelor degree is by the percentage of eight subjects calculated as follows;

3.2 Four compulsory subjects, Religion, English language, Mathematics, and Citizenship;

3.3 In addition to four qualifying subjects for admission. These are to be specified by the concerned colleges;

3.4 Admission to Diploma programs is based on the percentage calculated out of six subjects specified by the concern college and passed by the admission committee. Only applications with current certificates are allowed to apply.

3.5 Application for admission is via one application form prepared by admission committee. An applicant is not allowed to change or add choices after the submission of the form;

3.6 An applicant has the right to compete to all colleges of all universities if he/she has complied with the general and special admission conditions to institutions of higher education;

3.7 Each subject is counted once for admission;

3.8 Only one South Sudan Certificate of Secondary Education in one year is considered for fulfilling all the conditions.

4 Differentiation subjects should be as below:

4.1 Science Specialization (Biology)

Summation of the aggregate of the points of the following subjects (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, and Biology);

4.2 Science Specialization (Mathematics)

Summation of the aggregate of the points of the following subjects:

(Mathematics; Physics; Chemistry) and (Additional Mathematics or Computer Science).

4.3 Arts Specialization:

Summation of the aggregate of the points of the following subjects: (Geography, History and Commerce/ General Science);

5 A student nominated for admission in the General Admission and has not resigned within the period specified by admission committee and has not registered is given a chance to compete for admission after the elapse of one year,

6 A student who is nominated in the second round is not allowed to resign but if he/ she does not register in the college he/she can be given a chance to reapply and compete after the elapse of one year,

7 A student who has completed registration procedures in the college shall not be given a chance to apply again except if he/she falls under one of the following conditions:

- 7.1 A student who has registered in the college after nomination and has not completed the academic year is given an opportunity to compete after one academic year, the year in which the applicant registered after meeting all the admission conditions and requirements. Such a student is required to attach a letter of resignation from the academic affairs of the university issued in the same year to the admission application form;
- 7.2 A student dismissed academically is allowed to apply and compete after a year of his/her dismissal. He/she can be admitted to any other university other than the previous one if he/she qualifies. Such a student shall be requested to attach dismissal letter from academic affairs office of the university to the admission application form;
- 7.3 A graduate of a University is allowed to apply and compete provided that he/she attach a copy of his/her qualification. Such applicants can be admitted under Private Admission Program;
- 7.4 A student who resigns after first year can be allowed to reapply in public institutions on private admission;
- 7.5 University graduates are allowed to apply and be admitted above first year under private admission system with full tuition fees on the condition that he/she meets the minimum requirements to be admitted under Private Admission system in that specific college in the specific academic year. This kind of admission is done through the university;
- 7.6 University admission number is provided by the Directorate of Admission to a student nominated to study in any of the institutions of higher education by any of the admission types below:
- 7.6.1 General Admission which includes admission to Bachelor Degree and Diploma;
- 7.6.2 Private admission;

- 7.6.3 Direct Admission (Bachelor and Diploma);
- 7.6.4 Transfer from one institution of higher education to another or from abroad to South Sudan after completion of the first academic year in the institution originally admitted to;
- 7.6.5 Distance learning or mature students admission;
- 7.6.6 Any other admission in accordance to regulations passed by the National Council for Higher Education.

8 Transfers of Students:

- 8.1 Transfer in the first academic year is done through the Directorate of Admission in accordance to regulations and duration specified by the Admission Committee;
- 8.2 A student is transferred from one university to another in accordance to regulations below:
 - 8.2.1 To get acceptance from both the university he/she is transferring from and acceptance from the University he/she is intending to join.
 - 8.2.2 To be a qualified student and has obtained the minimum requirement of competition to the concern college in that particular year. Such a student can either be admitted in general or private admission in the same year in which he/she obtained secondary school certificate;
 - 8.2.3 Transfer from Private University to Public University can be done after the approval of the two universities. If there is no approval the student can resign from the private university and be admitted in a Public University as a private student. However, such a student is supposed to be academically eligible and meets all the admission requirements;

- 8.2.4 All the procedures of transfer are to be approved by the Directorate of Admission and a new university admission number is issued or the old one is retained;
- 8.2.5 The Admission Committee or the National Council for Higher Education can add any other conditions regulating admission.

9 Application to Admission

Application for Admission is carried out on the basis and regulations below:

- 9.1 Submission of the application form is done by the student personally with proof of identification or by the applicant representative with proof of identification together with the applicant identity;
- 9.2 A student is solely responsible for all the information written in the application form;
- 9.3 A student has no right to withdraw the application form after submission;

10 Cancellation of Admission

10.1 Admission of a student can be cancelled any time after the announcement of the admission results under the following conditions:

- 10.1.1 If the admission of the applicant is wrong and does not comply with all the regulations and basis governing admission;
- 10.1.2 If the applicant presented false information or incomplete and forged documents;

10.2 The Directorate of Admission has the right to take legal procedures against any applicant who presents false information or forged documents.

11 Conditions for Admission to Bachelor Degree

Conditions of admission to Bachelor Degree program are as follows:

11.1 South Sudan Certificate of Secondary Education, Academic section as follows:

11.1.1 Pass with a minimum of grade C in South Sudan Certificate of Secondary Education, academic section;

11.1.2 Pass in four compulsory subjects (English language, Religion, Mathematics, and Citizenship) plus pass in any four qualifying subjects specified by the concern college;

11.1.3 The percentage for admission is calculated according to admission regulations of each college (see chapter ten).

11.2 South Sudan Certificate of Secondary Education – Technical Section, this consists of Commercial, and Technical certificates. For this section admission is done according to:

11.2.1 Pass with a minimum of grade C in South Sudan Certificate of Secondary Education, technical section;

11.2.2 Pass in four compulsory subjects (Religion, English Language, Mathematics, and Citizenship) and pass in any four qualifying subjects specified by the concern college; (see chapter ten)

11.2.3 The percentage for admission for each college is calculated in accordance to its special conditions (see chapter ten).

12 Foreign Certificates:

- 12.1 Pass in all eight subjects from which admission percentage is calculated;
- 12.2 Religion and Citizenship shall not be considered as compulsory subjects for any foreign certificate for admission;
- 12.3 Foreign certificate shall be equated by the South Sudan Examinations Secretariat before any admission process is conducted;
- 12.4 The percentage for foreign certificates shall be calculated of two compulsory subjects (Mathematics and English) in addition to six subjects to be identified by the college of interest;
- 12.5 Holders of foreign certificates outside South Sudan have the right to compete and be admitted to institutions of higher education. They can either be admitted through general or private admission to public or private institutions;
- 12.6 The Directorate of Admission has the right to reconsider the evaluation of foreign certificates when it deems necessary;
- 12.7 Science and Technical section students can be admitted to Information Technology programs;

13 Science Section for Science Colleges – Biology:

Pass in Religion, English language, Mathematics, Citizenship, Biology, Chemistry, Physics and the best one optional subject for admission.

14 Science Section for Science Colleges – Mathematics:

Pass in Religion, English language, Mathematics, Citizenship, Physics, Chemistry, Additional Mathematics and the best one optional subject for admission.

15 Arts section for Colleges of Humanities and Social Sciences:

Pass in Religion, English Language, Mathematics, Citizenship any Commerce, Geography, History, and the best one optional subject for admission.

The previous conditions must be fulfilled by a certificate sat at one time for all the qualifying subjects.

CHAPTER TWO

PRIVATE / DIRECT ADMISSION

16 Basis and conditions regulating Private Admission

16.1 Private Admission shall be regulated on the following bases:

- 16.1.1 Every University is allowed to admit additional number yearly for studies on Private Admission system;
- 16.1.2 Every university is allowed to distribute the seats of private admission to its different colleges/institutes on the condition that it should not exceed 25% of the total number planned to that college for admission in that academic year for that college;
- 16.1.3 The percentage for every college should not be less than 1.2 percentage for admission as a minimum from the general admission for the college concerned;
- 16.1.4 Every university will determine the tuition fees for Private Admission in its different colleges;
- 16.1.5 The dividend from Private Admission should be utilized to assist development projects, improvement of the colleges and the university. The colleges that admit students on private admission system should be given appropriate portion from the tuition fees as support for their development;
- 16.1.6 The tuition fees for private admission shall not be reduced for students who are studying in government institutions of higher learning;
- 16.1.7 Foreign students shall be admitted as private student and shall pay in United States of America Dollars.

16.2 In observing what had been stipulated in the above articles, all the regulations, rules and conditions being used in the competition of general admission are applied in Private Admission Program.

17 Admission of the Offspring and Spouses of Employees in Institutions of Higher Learning.

The offspring and spouses of Employees in the Institution of Higher Education shall be admitted through Private Admission Program if they meet the following conditions:

- 17.1 He/she shall be in active service. This encompasses constitutional post holders or executives who are employees of the institution of higher education;
- 17.2 The employee shall have spent two years in service or one year after reinstatement in the Institutions he/she was serving;
- 17.3 Without prejudice to article (2), the offspring of the employees who have not spent two years in service to qualify for private admission, shall pay 50% of tuition fees subject to reduction to 25% after the completion of two years in service;
- 17.4 There should be a unified form issued by the Directorate of Admission, Evaluation and Authentication which includes the followings; date of appointment, date of permanent appointment in service, clarification that the employee is in active service. This shall be approved and signed by the personnel secretary, Academic registrar and the Vice Chancellor. This form shall be general for all those exempted;
- 17.5 Twenty-five percent of the total number planned for admission shall be considered for private admission in all the colleges;
- 17.6 The applicant will be admitted after the payment of the 25% of the fixed tuition fees for private admission for the concerned college;

17.7 The minimum percentage for admission should not be less than 1.2 percentage of the percentage for general admission for the concerned college in that academic year;

17.8 Every university shall have the right to determine the methods and ways of collecting tuition fees;

17.9 The offspring of the employee in the Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Technology shall be treated on equal footing with the children of the employees in the public institutions of higher education;

18 Admission of Offspring and Spouses of Pensioners in Public institutions of Higher Education

18.1 The admission of offspring of employees who have reached the age of compulsory retirement and were still in active service for the last 10 years shall be treated on equal footing with the offspring of the employees of higher education;

18.2 The admission of the offspring of the pensioners who have reached the age of voluntary pension and have served not less than five years shall be treated on equal footing with the offspring of the employees;

18.3 The offspring of the **deceased** in the institutions of higher education shall be treated on equal footing with the offspring of the employees.

19 The admission of the offspring and spouses of the Members of the Universities Councils

19.1 The offspring of the members of the Universities Councils shall be admitted in private admission after the payment of 50% of the tuition fees in their universities;

19.2 A student admitted in accordance with article (1) will continue to benefit from this privilege till his/her graduation from the university.

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CHAPTER THREE

UPGRADING AND SECOND ROUND ADMISSION

20 The number of students accepted for upgrading shall not exceed 10% of the total number registered in a specialization of the given year.

20.1 Upgrading applicants shall meet the following conditions:

20.1.1 Pass with minimum grade C in South Sudan Certificate of Secondary Education or its equivalent;

20.1.2 Meet the above conditions in one South Sudan Certificate of Secondary Education or its equivalent; to one index number and one date of examination.

20.1.3 Two years' diploma Program qualifies for entry to second year in Bachelor Degree Program and three years Diploma Program to third year in the Bachelor Degree Program as the maximum limit;

20.1.4 Holders of Diploma with distinction and credit should be immediately admitted for upgrading upon graduation;

20.2 The percentage of students admitted for upgrading should not exceed 10% of the total number of students registered in the academic year.

21 Conditions for Second Round Admission

21.1 The percentage of admission in the first round represents the minimum percentage in the second round;

21.2 An applicant who has been nominated for admission in the first round has no right to apply for admission in the second round

- 21.3 An applicant who has been nominated in the first round in Private or Foreign institutions has to resign from the place of his/ her nomination before applying for round two;
- 21.4 The applicant should personally submit his/ her admission form after presenting his/ her identity card or legally authorize somebody to submit his/ her application form;
- 21.5 An applicant nominated for second round admission is not permitted to resign his/ her seat. If the applicant has not resigned in the college, he/ she shall be given a chance for competition after one year from the time he/ she was nominated after meeting all the requirements;
- 21.6 Direct Admission shall be carried out by the universities and old certificates of the applicants and other necessary documents shall be submitted to the Admission office within one week after completion of the nomination by the universities;
- 21.7 Direct Admission shall include; old certificates (distance and Mature Admission).

22 Conditions for Distance Learning Admission

- 22.1 For the purpose of this Regulation a distance program student is:
- 22.1.1 A student who has not been given the opportunity for university regular education in spite of his appropriate academic qualification.
- 22.1.2 A student who studied at a university level which qualify him/her to be admitted above first year.

22.2 Admission in first year should observe the following

22.2.1 Student should have obtained Certificate of Secondary Education or its equivalent and should meet the conditions for admission in the year he/she obtained the certificate;

22.2.2 Two years should have elapsed on obtainment of the Certificate of Secondary Education.

22.3 The admission process and registration for distance learning as follows:

22.3.1 The university shall specify the planned number of students for admission every year;

22.3.2 The application process is done through the university;

22.3.3 The university should submit the necessary documents for admission to the Directorate of Admission for verification and allotment of admission number to the student.

CHAPTER FOUR

ADMISSION OF MATURE STUDENTS

23 Conditions for Admission of Mature Students

23.1 A mature student is a person who has completed secondary school to qualify for admission as a regular student and has met the following conditions:

23.1.1 The applicant should have long experience in work and famous for his/her intellectual productivity or possess rare experience or hobby or excels academically in one of the fields;

23.1.2 The applicant should have spent ten (10) years in work or experience as a minimum in the field of his work;

23.1.3 The applicant should not be less than thirty (30) years at the time of applying to the university;

23.1.4 The applicant admission shall be on individual basis endorsed by the senate of the university;

23.1.5 The admission shall only be in the theoretical colleges.

23.2 Admission of Mature Students is done through a committee formed by the senate of a university in accordance with the following provisions:

23.2.1 A mature student is treated like a regular student in terms of full- time study, attendance and commitment to academic field works;

23.2.2 The student can be admitted in any year (first, second year etc.) decided by the university;

23.2.3 The birth certificate should be obtained two years before applying for admission;

23.2.4 The number of Mature Students should not exceed 10% of

general admission in a given specialization;

- 23.2.5 The appearance of a mature student before interview committee or sitting for any test or examination, the university will decide which one is appropriate;
- 23.2.6 The applications are submitted to the universities and then approved by the Directorate of Admission;
- 23.2.7 The admission of the students is done through a committee.

CHAPTER FIVE
PUBLIC & PRIVATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER
EDUCATION IN SOUTH SUDAN

24 Public and Private Institutions of Higher Education in South Sudan

24.1 Public Universities - Bachelor Programs

UNIVERSITY OF JUBA – JUBA

University of Juba Consists of Fifteen (15) Schools and Thirty-seven (37) Specializations as hereunder:

1) SCHOOL OF MEDECINE

The School Awards Bachelor Degree in Medicine and Bachelor Degree in Surgery in six (6) years.

**2) SCHOOL OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND
ENVIORNMENTAL STUDIES.**

The School awards Bachelor Degree with Honors in five (5) years in the following specializations:

(Animal Production, Fisheries, Wildlife, Agricultural Science, Forestry Science, Geology and Mining and Environmental Studies).

3) SCHOOL OF APPLIED AND INDUSTRIAL SCIENCES

The School Awards Bachelor Degree with Honors in five (5) years in the following specializations: (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Biochemistry, Meteorology, Electronics and Instrumentation, Industrial Chemistry, Paper Processing, Biotechnology, Leather Technology, Sugar and Food Technology, Microbiology and Textile Processing). Specialization starts in second year.

4) SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING AND ARCHITECTURE:

The School awards Bachelor Degree with Honors in five (5) years in the following specializations:

(Civil Engineering, Mechanical engineering, Electrical Engineering, Architecture Engineering and Agriculture).

5) SCHOOL OF COMPUTER SCIENCE AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

The College awards Bachelor Degree in four (4) years in two specializations:

Computer Science and Information Technology.

6) SCHOOL OF EDUCATION

The School awards General Bachelor Degree in Education (Arts or Science) in four (4) years and Bachelor Degree with Honors in five (5) years, on merit, in the following specializations:

((Mathematics-Physics), (Biology-Chemistry), (Arabic Language-English Language), (English Language-English Literature) and (History-Geography). A student specializes in fourth year in one of the two subjects cited above; one of the subjects shall be major and the other one minor.

7) SCHOOL OF SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC STUDIES

The School awards a General Bachelor Degree in four (4) years and a Bachelor Degree with Honors in five (5) years, on merit, in the following specializations:

(Economics, Sociology and Social Anthropology, Statistics and Demography, Political Science).

8) SCHOOL OF BUSINESS AND MANAGEMENT SCIENCES

This school awards Bachelor Degree in four (4) years and Bachelor Degree with Honors in five (5) years in the following specializations: (Accounting, Business Administration and Public Administration). Specialization starts in second year.

9) SCHOOL OF LAW

The School awards General Bachelor Degree in Law in four (4) years.

10) SCHOOL OF ARTS AND HUMANITIES

The School awards General Bachelor Degree in four (4) years and Bachelor Degree with Honors in five (5) years, on merit, in the following specializations:

(Geography, History, Arabic Language, English Language, French Language, Russian Language, Mass Communication, Philosophy, Archeology, Religious Studies and Psychology). Specialization starts in second year.

11) SCHOOL OF COMMUNITY STUDIES AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT

The School awards General Bachelor Degree in four (4) years and Bachelor Degree with Honors in five (5) years in the following specializations:

(Development Communication, Rural Development, Community studies, - Library and Information Science).

12) SCHOOL OF ART, MUSIC AND DRAMA

The School awards General Bachelor Degree in four (4) years in the following specializations: (Fine Art, Music and Drama).

13) SCHOOL OF VETERINARY MEDICINE

The School awards general Bachelor Degree with honors in five (5).

14) SCHOOL OF MATHEMATICS

The School awards Bachelor Degree with honors in five (5) years in the following specializations: (Applied Statistics and Actuarial Science).

15) SCHOOL OF MEDICAL LABORATORY SCIENCES

The School awards Bachelor Degree with honors in five (5) years.

UPPER NILE UNIVERSITY – MALAKALAND RENK

(Studies Temporarily in Juba)

Upper Nile University consists of Ten (10) Faculties and Twenty (20) Specializations as hereunder:

1) FACULTY OF MEDECINE AND HEALTH SCIENCE.

The Faculty awards Bachelor Degree in Medicine and Surgery in six (6) years.

2) SCHOOL OF NURSING.

The School awards Bachelor Degree in Nursing Science in four (4) years.

3) FACULTY OF PUBLIC HEALTH.

The Faculty awards Bachelor Degree in Public and Environmental Health with honors in Five (5) years in following Specializations: (Public Health, Health Education, Environmental Health and Food Hygiene and Safety).

4) FACULTY OF VETRINARY MEDECINE.

The Faculty awards Bachelor Degree with Honors in five (5) years.

5) FACULTY OF AGRICULTURE.

The Faculty awards Bachelor Degree with Honors in five (5) years in the following specializations:

(Crop Protection, Agricultural Engineering, Food Science and Technology, Agricultural Economics, Agricultural Extension and Rural Development, Soil Sciences, Field Crop Production and Horticulture Crop).

6) FACULTY OF FORESTRY AND RANGE SCIENCE.

The Faculty awards Bachelor Degree with Honors in five (5) years in the following specialization:

Forestry, Range Science and Wildlife.

7) FACULTY OF ANIMAL PRODUCTION AND FISHERIES.

The Faculty awards Bachelor Degree with Honors in five (5) years in the following specializations:

Animal Production (General) and Fisheries Science.

8) FACULTY OF EDUCATION.

The Faculty awards General Bachelor Degree in four (4) years in the following specializations:

(Mathematics and Physics- Biology and Chemistry- Arabic Language and History- Arabic Language and Geography- Arabic Language and English Language and English Language and History).

9) FACULTY OF ECONOMICS AND SOCIAL STUDIES.

The Faculty awards General Bachelor Degree in four (4) years in the following specializations:

Accounting, Business Administration, Economics, Public Administration, Statistics and Demography, Sociology and Anthropology and Political Science.

10) FACULTY OF COMMUNITY STUDIES AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT.

The College awards General Bachelor Degree in the following specializations: Family Science (4) years, Communication (honor) in five years, Library Science honor(5) year, Rural Development (4) years, Community Studies (4) year

UNIVERSITY OF BAH AR EL GHAZAL – WAU

The University has Nine (8) Colleges and Twenty (20) Specializations these are:

1) COLLEGE OF MEDICINE AND HEALTH SCIENCE

The College awards Bachelor Degree in Medicine and Surgery in six (6) years. The College functions on semester system.

2) COLLEGE OF PUBLIC AND ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH

The College awards Bachelor Degree in Public Health in Five (5) years.

3) COLLEGE OF NURSING.

The College awards Bachelor Degree in Nursing in Five (5) years.

4) COLLEGE OF VETRINARY SCIENCES

The College awards Bachelor Degree in Veterinary Science in five (5) years. The College functions on semester system.

5) COLLEGE OF EDUCATION

CHAPTER SIX

APPLICATION TO UNIVERSITIES

25 APPLICATION TO UNIVERSITIES

Application to universities should be according to the following regulations:

- 25.1 The application form is given to the applicant after payment of prescribed fees, which is determined annually by the Directorate of Admission.
- 25.2 The application form is given to the applicant or his/her representative in the admission office in Juba or from any other temporary designated centers of admission in the universities and states.
- 25.3 The application form is submitted either to the admission office in Juba or to the temporary designated centers in the universities and states within the period specified by the Directorate of Admission. Application forms sent by post shall not be accepted.
- 25.4 An applicant should present his/ her identity document (nationality certificate or passport) on submission of the application form.
- 25.5 The applicant should apply with one admission form and one certificate. An applicant who applies with more than one admission form or certificate shall be ruled out of the competition.
- 25.6 An applicant applying with foreign certificate should present the original and copies of certificate and transcript for verification.

- 25.7 The applicant should keep the application slip and present it whenever it is requested. Without the slip no inquiry or request shall be considered.
- 25.8 The application form is submitted to the admission office or centers of the states by the applicant after presenting him/her identification documents. The applicant representative can submit the application form on behalf of his/her applicant after presenting identification documents of both (the applicant and the representative).
- 25.9 The applicant is solely responsible for the information in the application form.
- 25.10 The applicant is not allowed to amend or withdraw the application form after submission.

26 APPLICATION FORM

The application form should be filled carefully and accurately so that it reflects the right choices of the applicant. The applicant should consider more importantly the following:

26.1 BASIC INFORMATION

- 26.1.1 Name of the applicant in full.
- 26.1.2 The name of the school in which the applicant sat.
- 26.1.3 The year in which the applicant sat the examination.
- 26.1.4 Index number of the certificate of secondary education.
- 26.1.5 College codes of the choices.

26.2 CHOICES

The Applicant should arrange his/her choices of the colleges and departments in a way that matches his/her choices, percentage and the academic section either for bachelor degree or diploma. The applicant is allowed to register any number of choices but should not exceed fifteen (15). They are to be arranged according to his/ her

Preferences.

If the applicant is not nominated for the first choice, the second choice will be considered. The same procedure applies to the rest of the choices down the line till the applicant is nominated. Repetition of choices reduces the chances of nomination of the applicant. In order for the applicant to secure his/her nomination to a college compatible to his/her academic qualifications and ability to study in it, he/she should observe the following:

- 26.2.1 General admission conditions to Universities.
- 26.2.2 Special conditions for choosing the preferred colleges and departments.

The applicant should make correct choices in accordance with the general and special regulations. As such, the applicant should choose only colleges that meet the general conditions for admission to bachelor degree and diploma programs.

26.3 **Studying Dual Program:**

No student is allowed to study two programs (Bachelor Degree or Diploma) at the same time;

- 26.3.1 A student is allowed to join any program (to the level of Bachelor Degree or Diploma) after graduation from the program he/she initially joined after fulfilling all the conditions.
- 26.3.2 Students who finish with two degrees at the same time, the Directorate of Admission will only authenticate the degree of the program which he/she was nominated to study by the Admission Office.
- 26.3.4 The certificates of foreign students who study two programs at the same time will not be authenticated.
